

# Situation Report

Country: **Indonesia** Emergency: **Flash flood**

## A. Location Details

1. Date and Time of Incident	February 9, 2024, 15.30 February 21, 2024 February 24, 2024
2. Emergency Type	Flash flood
3. Country/Province/Prefecture/Districts affected:	Indonesia, West Nusa Tenggara Province, Sumbawa Regency
4. Current Situation	<p>Due to heavy rain in West Nusa Tenggara Province, flooding occurred in Bima City and Sumbawa Regency. The flood affected 3 sub-districts in the city of Bima, namely East Rasanae sub-district, Raba sub-district, and Mpuda sub-district. Floods submerged at least 6 sub-districts until 12 February 2024.</p> <p>February 9, 2024, at 13:30 WITA there was heavy rain in the Hulu Sumbawa District area. Caused floods inundating the entire riverbank from Samapu Village to the mouth of Labuan Sumbawa Village River. Because the high water discharge caused the overflow of the water embankment in the upstream area of Sumbawa District starting from 14:30 WITA local time.</p> <p>Flash Flooding was reported to have occurred on Friday, February 9, at around 15.30 WITA. The number of villages affected by the flood was 7 villages in Sumbawa Regency, namely: Bugis Village, Samapu Village, Pekat Village, Brang Biji Village, Brang Bara, and Lempeh Village.</p> <p>Flash flood occurred again on February 21 that affected wider to three district in Sumbawa Regency: Sumbawa District, Buer District, and Alas District.</p>

	<p>On February 24, a flashflood accured and affected to two new district Ropang District and Utan District.</p> <p><b>Lives affected</b></p> <p>1.606 families, 6.217 peoples, including 60 diffable, 790 children.</p> <p><b>Damages</b></p> <p>2 Mosques</p> <p>7 Primary schools</p> <p><b>IDPs camp</b></p> <p>There were 370 Household Evacuate to Military Sumbawa District Command</p> <p><i>Source: Regional Disaster Management Agency (BPBD) of Sumbawa (26 February 2024)</i></p>

- Clean water
- Logistics

### D. Humanitarian Response / Deployment

The local government has distributed bottled drinking water, instant food, limited blankets, and built emergency tents for refugees.

### E. Gaps & Constraints

The condition of the flash flood location in the dry area causes mud to enter residents' homes and public facilities. This incident is predicted to occur until end of February 2024 as long as heavy rain occurs.

So, displaced residents still need food, clean water and sanitation because the current aid is still insufficient and predictions of flooding will continue until end of February 2024.

The local disabled community specifically requested friendly sanitation facility for them.
